#### THERE IS STRENGTH IN NUMBERS!



From the days of the Caveman and square wheels to the 1930's construction of the Golden Gate Bridge that was engineered by Joseph Strauss, the ingenuity of man has truly come a long way!!! The exact time, designer and

location where the first wheel rolled into the world is unclear, but it has simplified life for many people

throughout history, and the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco has made life more convenient for over 112,000 motor vehicles that cross over the bridge every day.



The roadway of the Golden Gate Bridge is suspended from two massive, three-foot round cables. Each cable consists of of 61 bundles of steel wire, each bundle containing 27,572 small steel wires about the size of a pencil. To give

the cables great strength, a process invented in the 1800s called "Cable Spinning" was used to wind the cables together (this concept is also found in the Bible in the book of Ecclesiastes, 4:12 where it says, "a cord of three strands is not easily broken.") To the onlooker of the bridge, it appears the bridge is suspended from two large cables, but in reality, it is suspended from 55,144 tiny wires wound together that gives it great strength.



There is strength in numbers, a truth promoted by the apostle Paul when he used the human body as an illustration for the Body of Christ. Each cell in the human body is like an individual person in the Church. The faith of one member is multiplied exponentially when combined with the faith of every other member. Whether one wire in a cable, one cell in a body, or one believer of the church . . . . each individual part is important.

You will hear more on this beginning on April 14<sup>th</sup> as we begin a new sermon series developed by Pastor Shawn, "GPS". It is a series to help us each discover and understand our "Gifts, Passions, and our Story". I believe these messages will help each person in our church family identify how we can all minister together to maximize our Kingdom impact in the Newville and surrounding communities.

Let me leave you with the words of the writer from Hebrews: "And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as in the manner of some, but exhorting one another.
