New Life Church of God Mount Carmel, PA

Located in Mount Carmel, PA, this growing church has 42 regular attendees. The congregation is working hard to transform an old building into a code-blue homeless shelter. Last winter, 17 members of the community froze to death because of inadequate shelter. Needed improvements include: updating of un-grounded knob and tube wiring, patching their leaking roof, updating heating system. Their estimates are approaching \$50,000. Cots, security and licensing have been secured and their hopes are work can be completed before cold weather arrives this fall. The building also is the home base for God's Chuckwagon, a mobile food kitchen also serving the local population. Our financial gifts would greatly bless their community.
