

PAW PACKS & Other information

t's hard to believe that it was in January of 2016 that the first PAW Packs were taken to Newville Elementary School. It doesn't seem that long ago. We are now beginning our ninth year of fighting childhood hunger in our community. I've never counted how many churches are in our community, but I know that we received monetary or food donations from 23 of them this past year. Some of these churches are quite small, but they still make helping us one of their missions. We also have the support of many local businesses and organizations, as well as many, many individuals who care about the well-being of children. God has richly blessed this ministry. Those first food bags went to 16 children as part of a pilot program which quickly grew. Now each week we prepare for around 275-300 children.

It takes a lot of food to feed that many children! For example, we send home more than 1100 single serving boxes of cereal every month to our school children and use another 200 boxes of family-sized cereal to give to the families who pick up food here at the church. The canned vegetables that you donate go in and out of our cabinets quite quickly as we try to send two types home for the children each week, usually using 70-80 cans of each. Your donations definitely help so please keep them coming. We especially need corn and peas.

Please continue to pray for the children and families in our community that struggle to put food on the table every day. Pray too for our volunteers who work tirelessly to help this mission succeed. Thank you all for your support over the years. Together, all of us are making a difference in the lives of these children.

The next PAW Packs meeting is February 6 at 6:30 pm.

If you're heading to the grocery store, remember to pick up a few cans of peas, corn and/or green beans

for Paw Packs.

PRAYER CALENDAR MINISTRY

- 1. Pray for those dealing with flu, colds and other health issues. Pray there will be a good outcome as people's immune systems can kick in and common sense prevails.
- 2. Praise God that we can enjoy things without owning them. Seeing things, whether it's an object or a beautiful sunset, etc. is a priceless gift.
- 3. Pray for those with eye/vision problems, that they will be healed, if possible and no other injuries occur.
- 4. Pray for criticizers, that they will stop breaking down the spirits of others. There may be a reason they feel the need to put others down to make themselves feel better, but no excuse for hurting others.
- 5. Praise God for giving each person one or more special spiritual gifts, even if we don't recognize it. Don't be afraid to use it to serve God.
- 6. Pray for the children's youth ministries as they reach out and touch so many young people for Jesus. Differences are truly being made that will affect these kids for life and future generations. Pray for creativity and stamina for all involved. Pray that many more will come to know Jesus.
- 7. Praise God for the Bible, His written word. Pray for people who can't read or can't possess a Bible, that they would hunger for it's message. We are so blessed, but take it for granted.
- 8. Pray for those contemplating abortion, that they will consider the outcome before they go through with it. Pray they will be helped through the circumstances and be blessed. - 13. Praise God that there are people who love you. You may not realize who they all are, but you are truly more special to others than you think.
- 14. Pray for all of your loved ones, for good health and their salvation. While you are at it, pray for someone who is lonely and for someone you really don't care for all that much.
- 15. Pray for those who have received transplants, that there will not be any rejections or complications, but great health for all. Pray for the donors and their families, too.
- 16. Pray for all the women and girls of our church, no matter what age. Each one is important to Jesus and has a part to do in His plan for now and eternity.
- 17. Pray that as Christians, we will be good witnesses for Christ and not fall into the traps that some non-Christians set. We do not want to disappoint Christ or to give others reason to call us hypocrites, using us as an excuse to turn away from God.
- 18. Praise God for those who do small kindnesses each day. Has someone helped you in the past? Can you do a small unexpected favor for someone else today? What about some small act everyday? Even a prayer for someone is a kindness.
- 19. Everyone has some unspoken prayer need. Pray that those righteous needs will be answered.
- 20. In this day when there is so little thought for others, pray that those in our church and community that they can feel loved and accepted and will radiate that peace out to others. We all sin, but there are people out there who feel defeated, deserted and hopeless that anyone will ever care for them. They need Jesus, but they need somebody to show Him to them.
- 21. Praise God if you can eat and enjoy anything that you want. Some people have digestive issues or allergies. Some have no access to food for different reasons. We take our meals for granted. To many in this world, a small snack would seem like a feast.
- 22. Pray for Pastor Wayne, Elaine and their family, along with all the other pastors and their families, especially in our church. We are blessed to have so many, serving in various capacities.
- 23. Praise God that warmer weather is coming. Don't give up hope.
- 24. Pray that our government leaders will follow our constitution and not make choices that get them what they want personally, at the expense of the citizens. Pray for their salvation and conviction to do what is right in God's sight, and actually work together.


