The Pastor's Corner

I think we are all thankful that 2020 has just about come to an end . . . but will 2021 be any better???

I hate to say it, but I don't think January 1, 2021 will be a magic date that everything begins to turn around. I'm not being negative . . . just realistic!

With that being said, "Happy New Year"! I like everyone else is looking for things to turn around and get back to what everyone is calling "normal"! I'm not even going there, because normal can mean so many different things for different people!

I was driving down the road a few days ago, and the word "resilient" came to my mind. Actually the first time I recall hearing this word was several years ago when an Army Chaplin was talking about having resiliency in our lives. It was an interesting term and concept that had me thinking about how resilient is my life?

If you don't know what it means to be resilient, the simplest explanation I've read came from Psychology Today, and it said:

Luke 1:78 tells us, "A new day will dawn on us from above because our God is loving and merciful." The song 10,000 Reasons by Matt Redmond says, "The suns come up; it's a new day dawning. It's time to sing your song again. Whatever may pass and whatever lies before me, let me be singing when the evening comes. Bless the Lord, O my soul!"

- 2. Praise God for this new year with a horizon of opportunities to do our best for Him. How will you use them?
- 3. Pray for those dealing with depression. The glow of the holidays is past and if our focus is not on the warmth of God's love, it can be quite a letdown.
- 4. Pray for Pastor Wayne, Elaine and their family. We are thankful that God chose them to lead our congregation. Pray they will be blessed with good health and safety in all areas. Likewise, pray for the other pastors of our church and their families.
- 5. Pray for your family members, especially the unsaved ones. But be grateful for each one.
- 6. Praise God for the music in our church and other sources, especially songs that praise God. We have been very blessed to have musical talent in our congregation. Pray that the limits will soon be lifted and voices will be able to flow more freely.

- 25. How are your relationships with your spouse? Family? Close friends? Is it all you would like it to be? How about praying for them specifically every day and maybe speaking a blessing to them? Why not try it and see how things have changed by this time 6 months from now?
- 26. Praise God for those who do jobs in our church, that we take for granted. From those that run the sound system, do the bulletins/newsletters, plant and weed flowers, mow, snow removal, cleaning to name a few. They do it for God's
