### A MINISTRY SABBATICAL

In May, 2020, I had scheduled and was approved to take a ministry sabbatical, but like many other things, Covid had a way of changing plans!!! My sabbatical is now planned for this year.

Some may wonder what a ministry sabbatical is??? It is a period of time when ministry leaders take a pause from their full time ministry for the purpose of rest and renewal, both personally and professionally, towards continued excellence in ministry. This holds true for Elaine and me as the sabbatical is a time from the daily physical, emotional, spiritual responsibilities of being a pastor and spouse.

Sabbaticals are recommended by our Conference leadership and granted to pastors after 10 years or more of full time ministry. The sabbatical in ministry aids in preventing burnout and helps stimulate renewed creativity for future ministry.

For a sabbatical to be most effective, it requires a complete time away from the ministry at Newville for a short period of time, but we know it will have long-term benefits for all of us. Many hours of preparation have been happening to ensure the leadership of the church and others are prepared to keep the church focused on the Lord and moving forward with a Kingdom mindset.

The first day of the sabbatical will be Sunday, July 25th and I will be back in the pulpit on Sunday, November 7th. We are looking forward to begin and to end the sabbatical time with two silent spiritual retreats where we can really focus on listening to God and what he wants to speak into us about our relationship with Him, our relationship with each other, and for his direction for our continued ministry at Newville.

During this time, we will be doing a little bit of travel. I am registered at the Billy Graham Training Center (The Cove), in North Carolina where I will attend a three-day seminar on "Teaching and Preaching God's Word: Next Steps to Becoming a High-Impact Communicator". This will be taught by Pastor Chip Ingram who hosts the Living On the Edge radio program. At the end of the sabbatical time, we will wrap it up with our annual trip to the Outer Banks.

We are looking to be spiritually fed as we have more down time to spend in the Word, read several books I've been wanting to read, and we will also attend a variety of churches for worship every Sunday morning.

We will certainly miss being with all of you during this time, but we know you will be well cared for and fed spiritually by various pastors and others from the church as they bring you the Word on Sunday mornings.

Be watching for more details to come in the next few weeks. We will be making every effort to keep you informed. As always, we are looking forward to serving you in the years to come. In closing, we share with you the same encouragement from the Apostle Paul who said, "I/we thank God every time I/we remember you. In all my/our prayers for all of you, I/we always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."





# **Prayer Calendar**





- 1. Pray for those going through chemo, radiation or other treatments, that they'll go into remission or be healed otherwise. Also, that they will have strength and a personal relationship with Christ to carry them through.
- 2. Praise God for the times you get to spend with your family. We often take them for granted. Don't wait until it's too late.
- 3. Pray that people will celebrate this weekend responsibly and peacefully, with no mishaps.
- 4. Praise God for the freedom we have. Take a moment to remember all those who have sacrificed time or their lives so the rest of us have these blessings. We need to never take that for granted.
- 5. Pray for safety as farmers are working in the fields, bailing hay, etc. Heat and heavy machinery don't always mix well.
- 6. Praise God for the Youth department/leaders of our church. Pray their strength and creativity will continue so the kids and teens will always want to come and interact, learning more about Jesus and the need for Him their life.
- 7. Pray for pregnant women dealing with nausea, especially with heat that they will start to feel better soon, enjoying the rest of their pregnancy, having a healthy baby.
- 8. Pray for those going into nursing homes or assisted living, etc. that the transition will be as smooth as possible and new friendships will be formed, to make this a happier life stage than is expected.
- 9. Pray that our church can use the fireworks display as a way to reach out to the community and spark some interest that might draw some people back on Sunday morning.
- 10. Praise God for all the men and boys of our church, that they will have a deeper desire for Jesus and a better understanding of His will for their life.
