CAMP TIME!



PAW PACKS & Other information

Many thanks to everyone who purchased tickets for meals at Redemption BBQ. Remember that they need to be redeemed by April 30th.

Behind the scenes at PAW Packs ..before we pack the bags that get handed out each Friday, many volunteers work behind the scenes to gather food for the day. Once each month we send an online order to the Central PA Food Bank. In order to do so, one of our volunteers has had to take an online SafeServ course and pass a test to ensure that we know food safety rules and procedures. Some folks are under the impression that this food is free to us. That is not the case. They do offer some items, usually snack type things, at very little cost, but we pay for staples like canned soups, vegetables, peanut butter, etc.

This past year we started going twice each month to the Midwest Food Bank in Middletown to pick up food. We have an assigned day and time to be there and we are able to choose from the foods they have available that week. They are a faith-based organization whose mission is to help feed those in need. They "rescue" foods that have recently gone past their "best buy" dates and also purchase other foods. They do not charge for their food and have been a blessing to us.

In addition to this, we purchase items from warehouse stores like Sam's and BJ's. Food donations from many of our local churches are a great blessing to us. They save us several thousand dollars each year.

We are always looking for additional volunteers to help. You are welcome to stop by on a Friday morning to see how we operate. We would love to see you there.



- 1. Praise God for the people He has blessed you with, to love and be loved by. It is one of the greatest gifts He has given. Remember there are many different kinds of love.
- 2. Pray for 3 unsaved people you know today. Also, if you happen to read about a total stranger, pray for them and their salvation. YOU may be the only one who has ever prayed for them.
- 3. Pray for those who are feeling so discouraged that they are giving up on life and their dreams. Pray they can find God's perfect will for their life and achieve their goals, that someone will stop them from the ultimate giving up.
- 4. Pray for missionaries wherever they are and whoever they are witnessing to, that lives will be changed and turned to Christ forever. While some are leaving the mission fields because of unsafe political areas, others will be entering the mission fields soon. Whether foreign or more local, each one is put in the spot to minister to the people God has ordained them to teach, including you.
- 5. Pray for all the women in our church, for good health and that each one will develop a deeper relationship with Jesus.
- 6. Pray for our teens and young adults as they develop their independence, that they will realize that relationship with Christ brings real freedom. This is especially important as many will soon be graduating and making major life decisions.
- 7. Pray for all those involved in the Middle East conflicts. It has certainly been a long ongoing battle. But it appears Bible prophecy is being fulfilled before our eyes. Above all, as scary as it may seem, pray for God's will to be done. Keep praying Psalm 91.
- 8. Pray for converts in countries where Christians are the minority. Pray that entire villages will come to know Christ as their Lord, that they will not be persecuted.
- 9. Praise God for stamping our debt of sin "Paid in full" when we receive Christ as our Lord.
- 10. Pray for the Connection Youth All Nighter that is to take place tonight. Pray they will have fun that results in a new or deeper relationship with Christ, that will carry over into their every day life. Pray for the leaders and chaperones, as well.
- 11. Pray for all the babies and children of our church, that they will grow up with a real hunger for Jesus in their lives. Also, pray for those unborn babies to have a chance at life, that the women will find a pregnancy center and not planned parenthood.
- 12. Praise God for the Mother and other nurturing people He has given you as a role model. Either how to or how not to act, each one teaches us many valuable lessons.
- 13. Pray for our church council, for kindness and wisdom in all things discussed and voted on. Some choices can be complex. None of it is taken lightly.
- 14. Praise God for giving each person He created at least one Spiritual Gift. There are so many, yes YOU can do things to serve God. Things as simple as praying for others or sending a card or note (or putting it in their church mailbox). The ladies who do the card ministry make it easy to do this. And the proceeds go to debt reduction. (Thank you ladies!) So many other talents are important, too. If you need help to determine your specific gift(s), just ask of the Pastors for help.
- 15. Pray for those who are fighting addictions. It's on the calendar often, but it is a daily battle. If the only way they can beat it is to get physically ill at the temptation, maybe that is God's way of helping them to not want that item.
- 16. Pray for Pastor Wayne, Elaine and their family, for safety, good health, happiness and overall well being. And prayers for the other pastors who serve in our church and their families too. We are truly blessed to have brave, Godly leaders.
- 17. Praise God for the Paw Packs team and all those involved in giving to show love to the children who would otherwise be so hungry. It not only fills the need of hungry tummies, but as they grow up and realize others cared for them, hopefully they will pay it forward to others in need.
- 18. Pray for our soldiers who are still away from home, for safety and wisdom in dealing with stressful situations. Pray for their families, too. Also, pray for all those veterans who have served in the past. All gave some and some gave all. They deserve our thanks and respect.
- 19. Pray for all the men of our church, that they'll experience God's grace in their life, in a new way.
- 20. Pray for our country. Things may look pretty bleak and there may be a lot of division. But God is still in control. He tells us to repent and obey Him. We need to be praying fervently and expectantly, in Spiritual warfare for our country to come back to Christ.
- 21. Pray for people who have gotten caught up in cults, that someone will reach them for Jesus before it's too late.
- 22. Praise God for the beautiful sunrises and sunsets. Only He could have come up with that kind of beauty.
- 23. Pray for all the pastors in our area, their continued devotion to God and their specific ministries as they reach out to the community. May their outreach of the Biblical truths bear a huge harvest, too. We can be very thankful that these congregations work well together.
- 24. Pray for those suffering from brain trauma or other head injuries. The results may not be immediate, but can sure make a huge impact on the lives of the injured as well as their family
- 25. Pray for people who are harboring bad feelings or grudges, that they will find a way to forgive those who have hurt them and get some inner peace, that they will be forgiven, too.
- 26. Praise God for Neighbors in Christ and all the volunteers who work to make it a successful ministry for helping those in need.
- 27. As we celebrate the first summer holiday weekend (Memorial Day), pray that people will be responsible in their actions, so there are fewer accidents and mischief. Instead, let them remember the real reason for this holiday.
- 28. Praise God for your home. It may be small or large. But is a roof over your head. There are so many people out there who wish for that luxury.
- 29. Pray for new church plants, that unchurched people will be drawn to them and find out what they have been missing, by not knowing Jesus as their Savior.
- 30. Pray for those who are in nursing homes and feeling so lonely. Many have lost their spouse, their health, their eyesight and have gained aches, pains and other issues that younger people don't realize. Many have outlived their friends and may not have family or at least no one who comes to visit. How sad! Is there something we can do to cheer these people? Prayers are an easy and important thing, but is there more?
- 31. Pray that we can attack the problems in our lives, not the people around us. Pray for patience, kindness and love.
