Many times, it's about** our perspective. Recently, I was listening to a sermon while at the gym and the pastor was talking about **the war within our minds. Specifically, he said, "You can't change your circumstances, but you can change your perspective."** ~Craig Groeschel. **The first place that Satan attacks us is our minds. He fills us** with lies and comparisons and then we focus on these things which then leads to paranoia, bitterness, greed, etc. This Thanksgiving month, let us remember everything that God has given to us, both people and possessions are a GIFT. And when the enemy attacks our minds and tries to fill us with negative perspectives, let us remember how blessed we truly are and shift the perspective to thankfulness. You all are a gift and blessing to Bethany and I and this thanksgiving month, I am incredibly thankful for my **"Chamily." (Church-Family)**
