Use the time you're already spending to further your relationship with Christ and to spur those around you in theirs.**

Is it of eternal significance? There are plenty of people who will tell you what you should do, but what is God saying? The Gospels have lot of examples of when Jesus was 'supposed' to be doing something and He just went somewhere else. He did what the Father was telling Him to do. And sometimes that was just going away to spend time with Him.**

**When's the last time you just spent time with the Father? No agenda, just you and Him. It's ok to stop the things you 'should' be doing and just be with Him. He's waiting for you.**
