



16. Tonight is the 5th quarter meeting. Second one for the school year. An excellent outreach to get teens into the church who may never have gone anywhere, in a setting they can be comfortable in. Please pray for a good turnout and follow up possibilities.
17. Praise God for First Responders. Police, firemen, EMTs, Life Lion, etc. Many lives are saved because of their willingness to put themselves on the line. Pray for safety in all areas of their lives.
18. Pray for those who feel so overwhelmed by stress that there seems to be no hope. Sometimes we only see now, not what's ahead in Heaven. Pray that there will be a peace that alleviates their anxiety.
19. Praise God that even when doctors say there is no hope, God often has other plans and the power to make those plans happen. Keep praying for those who desperately need that help and hope.
20. Pray for the Inter Church council meetings as they plan ways to work together to reach others for Christ. And for Neighbors in Christ, for wisdom and discernment in how to help those in need the best ways possible.
21. Praise God that when a family crisis occurs, it can pull you together in an even tighter bond, and for the new people who enter your life because of it.
22. Wow! Fall is here already. Praise God that you made it through summer and cooler weather is on the way.
23. Pray for the people you really don't want to pray for Jesus says Love your enemies and pray for them. Anyone who sticks in your mind who has been less than kind to you. You honestly never know what battle they are fighting. Truth be told, we never know if someone else might be praying for us in this, if we have had a bad day and acted less than graciously.
24. Pray for all the females of our church, that their love for Christ will shine through as a beacon to others.
